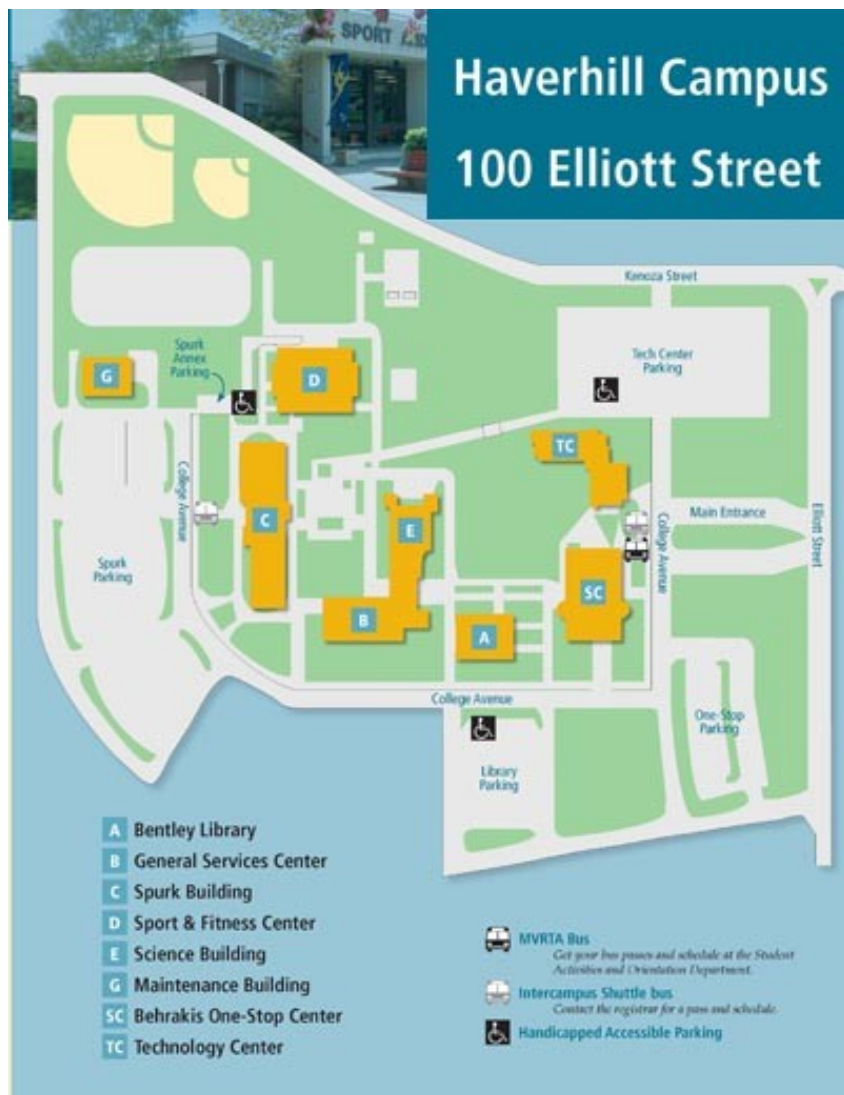

Coming from the South (on Route 495 North): Take Exit 52 and turn *Left* onto Rt. 110 . Then take first *Left* onto Elliott Street. Proceed to NECC Main Entrance.
