Proposed Action(s):

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a five-year capital plan for projects anticipated to receive federal aid.

The Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) details the projects to be completed by MVMPO staff in a given planning year (October 1 through September 30 of the following year).

The MVMPO Agreement details how stakeholders in the region will advance a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive planning process. The proposed amendment changes the membership position from Merrimack Valley Planning Commission Advisory Board Chair to Merrimack Valley Planning Commission Executive Director.
