Parker River National Wildlife Refuge Boat Ramp

The Parker River National Wildlife Refuge maintains a small boat ramp on the Plum Island River off a narrow dirt road across from Parking Lot 1. Parking is in this paved lot can accommodate well over 100 vehicles. There is a fee charged to enter the Refuge but there is no additional fee to use the boat ramp. Access to the river from the ramp is good at all tides. There may be powerboat traffic in the river at certain times in the summer.
